- Vintage dolls (at least 20 years old)
- Modern toys & dolls (Action figures, Lego, General toys, Games Trains & Vehicles, Card Collections and more)

### 2024 Doll & Toy Show Guidelines:

1. The Doll and Toy Show is open to all interested parties free of charge;
  - **Entries will be accepted** between **4:00 pm - 6:00 pm on Monday, June 17, 2024**, at the 4<sup>th</sup> Street Civic Center (Upper Level). Special accommodations can be made if this time does not work, please contact us to coordinate a time that works for you.
  - Doll and Toy show will be **open to the public Tuesday, June 18<sup>th</sup> & Wednesday, June 19<sup>h</sup> from 10 am – 5 pm**
  - **All entries must be picked up between 5 pm- 7 pm on Wednesday June 19<sup>th</sup>.**
2. You may enter battery operated items, but you are responsible for turning them on and off, if you wish to do so during the show. No electricity will be provided. Entries that could cause permanent damage to walls or floors are not permitted.
3. The Wythe Arts Council, or any other entity involved with the Chautauqua Festival or otherwise, will not be held responsible for anything lost, stolen or damaged. Please use discretion on items to include in your display.
