Chautauqua: (pronounced sha tauk' wa)... of Seneca Indian origin; a name of a place, variously represented as titles in early (chiefly French) writings and maps... literal meaning "one has take out fish there..." ... which may account for the relationship to Lake Chautauqua in southwestern New York. Chautauqua, NY Is the site of the educational assembly started in 1874 and is still in existence today.

In the late 19th century, the Chautauqua movement became a popular form of adult education and entertainment in the United States. Using noted lyceum speakers (such as Teddy Roosevelt and William Jennings Bryan) and local talent, the movement literally spread throughout the country, traveling in caravans and setting up their tent performances in towns with primary access to the railroad. In the 1920's; Wytheville, VA was a stop on the Chautauqua circuit, reportedly known as the "Redpath Circuit" which ran perpendicular to the "White & Meyer Circuit" that crossed the rural Midwestern United States, where Chautauqua was particularly popular. The Chautauqua lectures, musical features, dramatic arts and children's activities rose in popularity during the 1920's, followed by its demise, brought on by the Great Depression and the rise of the film industry. In 1985, the Chautauqua Festival was rejuvenated in the southwest VA community of Wytheville, and has been a source of entertainment, enjoyment and education again over the past thirty-nine years.
