You will receive your email letting you know if your work has been accepted for this year's show on or before June 9th. After that time, depending on the number of spaces remaining, approval will be on a first come first served approval basis, until September 15th. Our hope is that we can go ahead and get all 40 spaces booked and approved right after June 1st. This will ensure a lot less work for your jury. I appreciate your patience with this process change. We feel that it will ensure that quality remains top notch, while getting commitments to the festival in a timely manner.

Information about this year's Art at the Crossroads

This year Art at the Crossroads is happening again, in partnership, with the Millwald Theater's Apple 'Atcha Fest: A Celebration of the Arts. The entire weekend, Thursday through Saturday, the Apple 'Atcha Fest will be showcasing Appalachian artists and musicians in various performances and demonstrations. Art at the Crossroads will be the art vending portion of the festival and will take place from 10 am until 4 pm on Saturday, October 19th, 2024, at which time you may start to pack up. Every entry will be required to stay from 10am-4pm.
