 - All entries must be picked up between 5pm- 7pm on Tuesday, June 21st.
2. You may enter battery operated items, but you are responsible for turning them on and off, if you wish to do so during the show. No electricity will be provided. Entries that could cause permanent damage to walls or floors are not permitted.
